



These Are PA's Most Luxurious Hotels, U.S. News Says

Planning a getaway in Pennsylvania? You may want to read this first.

U.S. News & World Report has just released its rankings of the very best luxury hotels in the state and nation.

The Four Seasons hotels stand out among other chains in the U.S., placing at the very top of a new set of rankings of the best hotels in the country. The 2019 rankings, released by U.S. News & World Report, look at the top luxury hotels and resorts in the country and in every state.

U.S. News awards the top 10 percent of ranked hotels, or hotels that fall at or above the 90th percentile, with a gold badge, the publication explains in its methodology. The hotels that rank at or above the 70th percentile are awarded a silver badge.

In Pennsylvania, five hotels received a gold badge while eight hotels were awarded a silver badge.
