Finally stepping out of the second-city shadows, Philadelphia has emerged as a thriving metropolis, home to **award-winning restaurants**, world-class historic sites, and an exciting young-professional culture. As the city has grown up, so too have its accommodations. The top hotels no longer satisfy just overnight school groups, instead offering conveniently located, service-driven stays that are anything but basic. The options range from sleek, big-name hotels to boutique independents—plus a new breed of microhotels, catering to the part of you that likes the anonymity of Airbnb but can't go without thousand-thread-count sheets or concierge service. No matter where you fall on the amenity spectrum, there's a Philadelphia hotel to suit your needs.

## **The Logan Philadelphia, Curio Collection by Hilton** →

After pulling off busy Benjamin Franklin Parkway, the Logan's calm, covered driveway and friendly valet will instantly make you feel at home. Step inside and the theme continues: The lobby is laid out like a living room, with lounge seating, a self-service coffee bar, oversized fireplace, cozy library, and unique art installations. (The hotel holds more than 1,800 locally made works of art detailing the history of Philadelphia, much of which the guests can tour via the hotel's smartphone app.)

Make sure to end at least one of your nights at the ninth-floor rooftop bar, Assembly—the space has breathtaking, panoramic views, which stretch all the way from the Philadelphia Museum of Art to City Hall—and to sign up for a treatment (say, reflexology, or a scalp massage) at the subterranean spa.
